Mike & Tanya Vierling started the 'Hawkley Vierling Foundation', a non-profit pregnancy and infant loss awareness foundation in honour of their late infant son Hawkley Anthony Vierling. Through this foundation, they hope to provide support, education and awareness to people who have endured, or know someone who endured a miscarriage, ectopic pregnancy, a stillbirth, or the loss of an infant.

In July 2011, Mike & Tanya Vierling hosted a five-kilometer walk, a barbecue and a candlelight vigil to remember infants who have passed away, and to provide support to people who attended.
